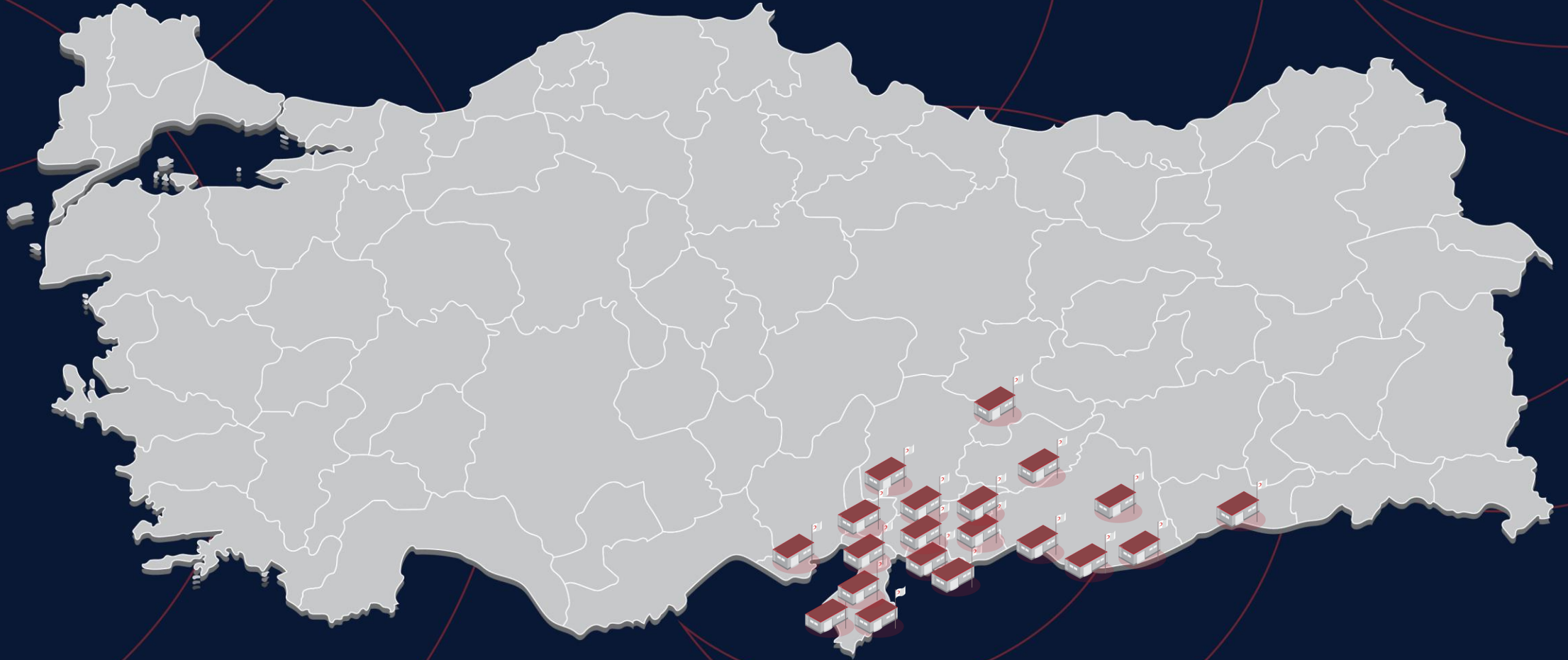

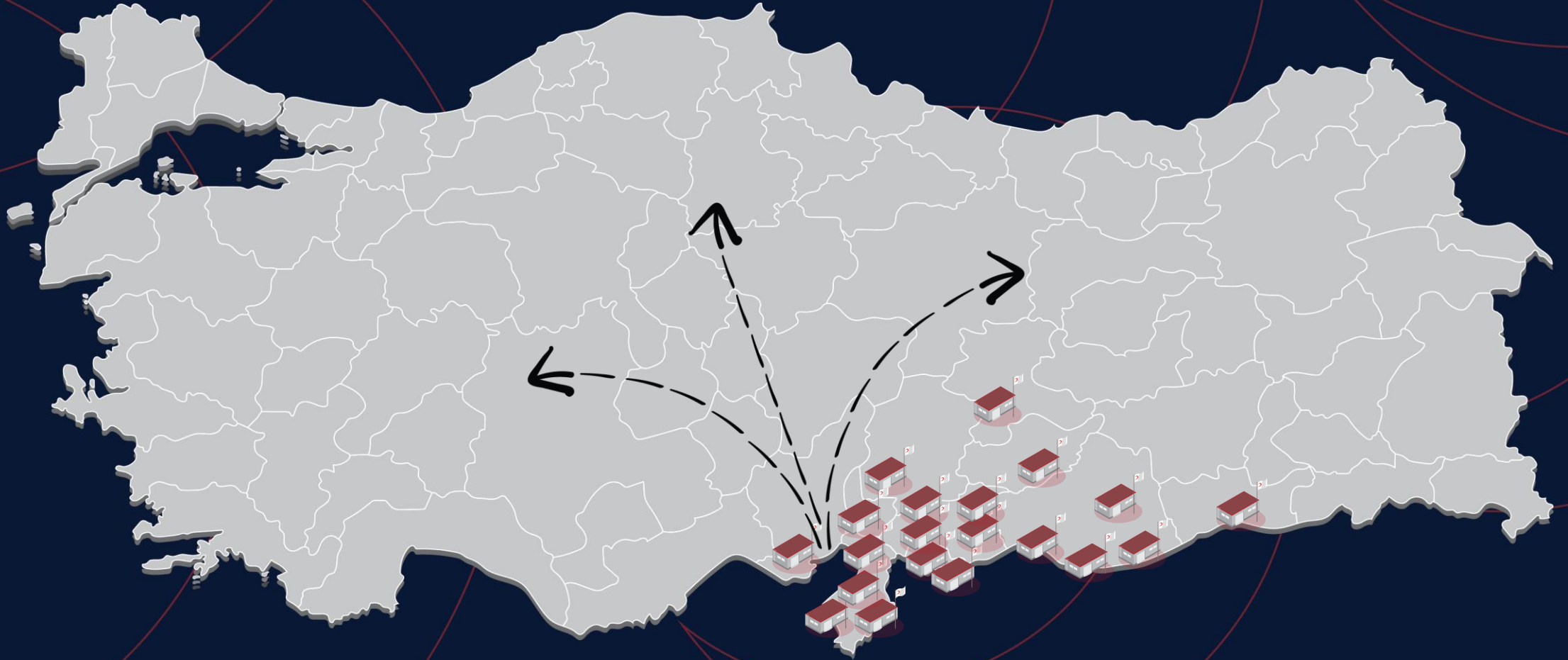

 - Existing ESSN beneficiaries meeting C-ESSN criteria



People-Centered Approach of the ESSN set light on beyond Basic Needs

- **Referring and sensitization individuals, and tracking systematically**
- **Information provisions through Call Center, Service Centers, and via outbound calls.**
- **Initiation of protection component, in March 2017**
- **Launch of SEE component, in April 2021**

2023; Economic Top-up to all ESSN and C- ESSN recipients due to economic fluctuation.

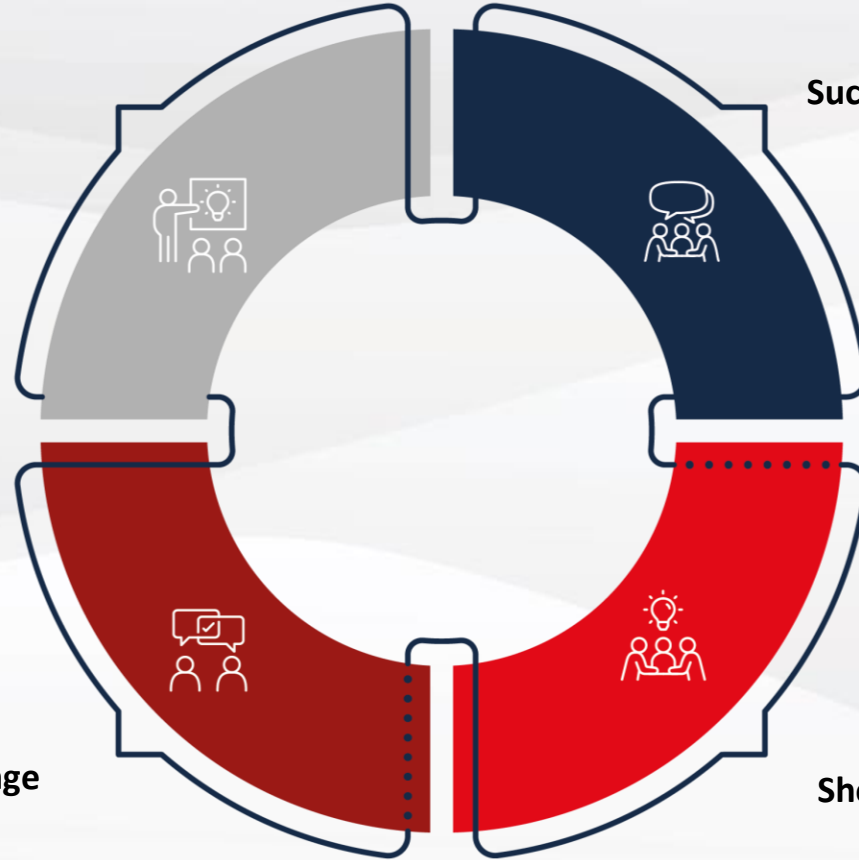
